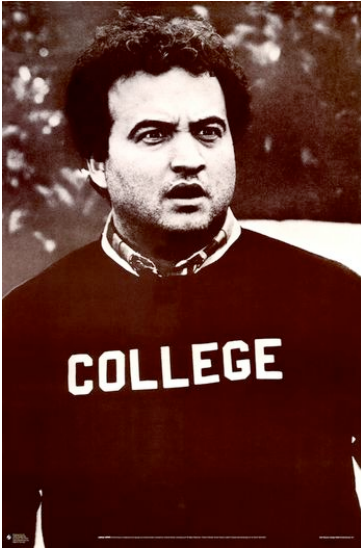


Senior Moments

Student who complete these projects before the end of the block should use the time to work on their senior projects, continuing research on colleges or other post-high school options, or studying for ACT or SATs.
